## Rosters

Effective **November 1st**, no one will be allowed to shoot that is not already listed on the standings sheet that week. If you need to add someone, it must be done **the week prior** so that the player is listed on the standings sheet **before** he subs. See page 3 of the rule book under rule 1.D.4.

## Rules

A couple of quick reminders; I got a call about the table at Bonnie & Clydes not being in playing condition. I believe they stated that the rails are offset and not installed correctly, causing the balls to jump up off the playing surface as well as un-level and cloth. I have not had time to check it yet so please take the initiative and have this fixed **PRIOR** to your next home match. Remember, teams are expected to double check the tables prior to start time so if you are scheduled to shoot there, get there early and double check it. If the table is deemed unplayable, the matches may have to be either postponed or moved to the opponents bar or schedule flip flopped, or whatever the officers decide to do with it until it is repaired to playable condition. Again, I am strictly going off the call I received so one or two of the officers will have to go out there as soon as possible to double check it. In the meantime, as I stated, team Captains double check it when you get there to make sure it is ok, pursuant to rule **1.B.8**, which states that 'Any Sponsor equipment issues must be settled prior to the start of League play. No disputes will be allowed after the start of the first game'.

## Scoresheets

Please make sure that your lineups match up prior to the match start time. Remember that the home team sets the order your guys shoot in ie; 2, 1, 3, 5, 4 or whatever, and the away team matches up their shooters in that same order ie; your number 2 shoots their number 2, your number one shoots their number 1 etc. If there is a tie for any of the shooters, home or away, the home team gets to decide who shoots who for those ties only. Also make sure that your scoresheets match up **BEFORE** you actually sign off on them. We are still having issues with sheets not matching up when I get them.
