Illegal Shooters

Again this past week, a team used an illegal shooter! Because you have to look on the standings sheet to find the averages anyways, I assume that the other team allowed this per the unwritten '*Sportsmanship Rule*'. Captains should be looking at the standings sheet closely to make sure that all shooters are listed on there before the

match is allowed to start. The rules are very clear, and there for a reason! Don't put teams in the position to feel guilty about not allowing illegal shooters to play, and then you feeling that they are not being a Sportsman. It isn't fair to them that they are prepared & follow the rules, yet others don't care to. Get your rosters finalized and follow them!!

Rosters

Effective immediately, no one will be allowed to shoot that is not already listed on the standings sheet that week. If you need to add someone, it must be done the **week prior** so that the player is listed on the standings sheet **before** he subs. See page 3 of the rule book under rule 1.D.4.

Also, remember that rosters will be **final** on **January 1st** and you will **no longer be able to add anyone at all**, much less the week before so please get your rosters in!! Additionally, I know for a fact that there are a couple names spelled wrong. Please review the sheets!
