PERMANENT ROSTERS

League Rule 1.D.4. There will be an open team roster from the start of the season until November 1st. By November 1st each team must turn in a finalized roster listing ten (10) shooters. From November 1st to January 1st only people listed on the standings sheets the night of will be allowed to shoot. Substitutions to this roster will be allowed, however, any player addition or removal requests must be presented to the League Secretary for confirmation and in time to make that weeks standings sheets. After January 1st there will be no changes allowed to the team rosters at all!

Table Runs

Congratulations to Tim Henry, and Josh Bourdo on your table runs this week, and to Darren DeVuyst on your eight ball break this week.

<u>Pool Tables / Equipment</u>

Per league Rule 1.B.1 All tables will be inspected halfway thru the season. We will be doing this over the Thanksgiving Holiday so please make sure your table complies with all league rules. This may include, but is not limited to, lines drawn designating the kitchen, bridge, chalk/powder, lighting, loose rails, felt in playing condition, level table, etc. Please see page 2 of your rules packet for specifics. Also, refer to Rule I.B.9. All infractions, will incur a \$5 fine if not rectified within two weeks of notification from officers. This will be deducted from the team's prize money.

League Dues

Numerous shooters have not paid their second half league fees, due on the **13th week**, **which is December 9th**, the second Monday after Thanksgiving. There is no reason to be late with these! Entire team forfeits will be enforced!

ROSTERS / SUBS

This has happened to two or three different teams the last two or three weeks. Teams have showed up with a shooter that IS NOT on their roster and expected him to be able to shoot that night. Those two or three shooters have been allowed to shoot, as the teams were nice enough to allow it to happen, but this cannot continue. League rules are what they are for a reason, and all rules have been voted on and administered by all players in the league, thus should be enforced as such. Effective immediately, (actually November 1st), no one will be allowed to shoot that is not already listed on the standings sheet that week. If you need to add someone, it must be done the week prior so that the player is actually listed on the standings sheet before he subs. See page 3 of the rule book under Rule 1.D.4. Double check that all of your subs are listed and that they are spelled correctly. Also, you can always upgrade players back to a "sub" status from "inactive", but you also need to do that a week ahead of time as well.
