ROSTERS

It is **UNBELIEVABLE** how many people just ignore the rules anymore, or think they don't apply to them! Rosters were final as of January 1st, 2020. This is NOT a NEW RULE! It has been this way for years! Additionally, A reminder of this has been on **every Pool News** almost all year until about two weeks ago, and I have asked that you double check your rosters to make sure no one got missed! **See Rule 1.D.4.** There will be an open team roster from the start of the season until November 1st. **By November 1st, each team must turn in a finalized roster listing ten (10) shooters. From November 1st to January 1st only people listed on the standings sheets the night of will be allowed to shoot.** Substitutions to this roster will be allowed, however, any player addition or removal requests must be presented to the League Secretary for confirmation and in time to make that weeks standings sheets. **After January 1st there will be no more changes allowed to the team rosters! UNREAL GUYS!**

Team Forfeits / Individual No Shows

For team bye weeks, I still need you to send me a copy of your scoresheet filled out in full. This is so that I know which of your shooters that I am supposed to credit the wins to. I know that may seem obvious to some, but there are a few teams that have more than five guys qualified as a regular, and one team that does not even have five guys qualified. Also, if a team has just one guy that does not show up for a match, you need to put the regulars name in the slot instead of a subs name. Even if you are expecting a sub to show up for that regular, if he doesn't actually make it there for some reason, then the regular gets charged with the losses, thus the reason for having the regular's name listed. This is per **League Rule 3.51.**
