Prize money will also be distributed that night. All players should attend that night to claim your prize money and/or awards. Don't forget to bring a bottle of booze from your bar to raffle off that night. Numerous teams have forgotten this in the past!!

All Star Shooters

The top shooter on each team is eligible to shoot in the all star tournament. The **top 5 teams**, according to records, get to send **2** shooters to shoot. You must have shot 75% of the games (regular), to qualify. If your top shooter cannot shoot that night, someone from your team can shoot in their place, but they must have qualified with 75% as well to do so. Anyone not showing up will be considered a forfeit and bye.
