Rules Review - Cue Ball Size

Rule I.B.7. Varied cue ball sizes are allowed but all tables used for league play must maintain the same size cue ball through out the length of the scheduled season. **This means that if a player goes to a bar to practice an hour before a match, (or even the day before the match), the cue ball that is on that table must be the same as what they use the night of league play.** If a team is replacing a cue ball to a newer one of the same size and weight the day of, that is ok as long as it is the **same size and weight as the one that is there for the public to practice with all year long, every day.**

League Fees

Due last week was the remainder of your league fees for the year. Several teams still have not paid them in full so I need them **TONIGHT** or **your match will automatically be forfeited in it's entirety**, even if only one shooter has not paid. It is up to each team Captain to ensure that all of your shooters comply immediately!!!

Final Rosters

Due by **January 1st** is your finalized roster of five regulars and five subs. You will no longer be able to change or add anyone at all after that, not even a week ahead of time. For teams with more than five subs, you must narrow it down to only five. Please do so tonight and write it on your scoresheets. This actually means that you should have this done by today, the 14th, as after that we don't shoot again until January 4th.

Lucky Mojos

At this point, your team is the only one that cannot seem to adhere to this rule listed to the left and below here. Either you play your matches with the cue ball that is on the table all week, or you take the one from behind the bar that they bring out right before you start your matches and make sure that one stays out ALL WEEK long for anyone to practice with during the week. These are rules the league voted on so we need to enforce them.

Safety Shots

Safety shots are not allowed in our league. The rule says that the penalty is loss of shot, but that is a given and was a mis-print. It was originally voted as loss of game. I have gotten many complaints of shooters playing blatant safety shots. If the same names keep coming up, a meeting will be held to decide what penalties to impose on those specific shooters.
