Captains (Ineligible Players)

RULE REVIEW

Rule 3.10. DEFLECTING THE CUE BALL ON THE GAMES OPENING BREAK. On the break shot, stopping or deflecting the cue ball after it has crossed the head string and prior to hitting the racked balls is a foul and loss of turn (ie; miscue etc. Cue ball must be allowed to stop rolling on its own). The opponent has the option of receiving the ball in hand behind the head string and breaking, or letting his opponent re-break. If the latter is the case, all table runs and eight ball breaks are still applicable. (Modification of BCA Rule 3.8) (Modifies BCA 4.7) (Ref. 3.6)
