## Pool League Banquet

The Pool League Banquet will be held on **Saturday April 6th**, at Rivermoor Country Club in Waterford. We will be having a Banquet Committee meeting sometime this coming week to discuss menu items as well as iron out any details with the Rivermoor staff. League President, **Josh Bourdo**, is working on this and will set up a time to meet with them. I will put the details on the Pool News as well as on our Facebook page and website as soon as he gets specifics from them. Josh has also once again convinced **McDermott Cue** to sponsor another tournament for us. The tournament will be the same format as last year, with team partners being blind drawn, one from the top half, and one from the bottom half of the standings. **There are only a certain amount of spots open for this tournament, so it is first come first serve. You need to get your \$5.00 entry fee to Josh himself in order to get signed up**, so we recommend that you do that personally rather than give it to your Captain, or a friend. Once the tournament signup sheet is full, Josh will start a waiting list for people to sign up on, so that in the event someone backs out last minute for whatever reason, then he will refer to the top of that waiting list for replacement shooters. Again, that waiting list is also first come first serve so the sooner you get signed up the better. I am going to need each teams count as far as how many people you will have attending the banquet. **Each team is allowed to bring up to 14 people to the banquet, same as last year.** Please email or text your numbers to me as soon as you can as well. I am going to try and put them all together in a slideshow or something for the banquet.
